GRADUATION WITH EQUITY AND EXCELLENCE

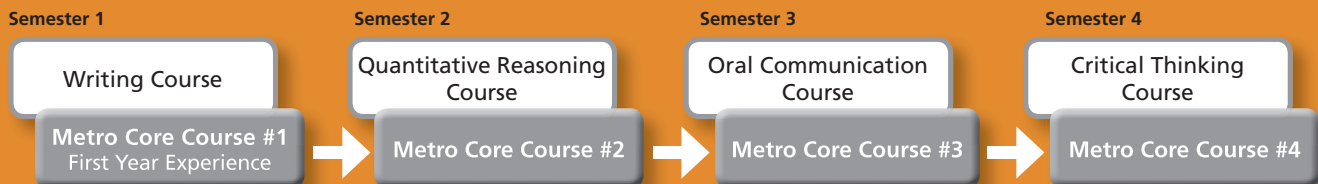
Each Metro Academy (Metro) reconfigures the first two years of college to create a ‘school within a school’ for up to 140 students. A cohort of students co-enrolls in two linked general education classes each semester over four semesters. Outreach focuses on high schools and youth agencies that serve students who are first-generation, low-income and/or underrepresented. A community college or university can host any number of Metro Academies, each with a broad career or topic theme, e.g. Health, Science, Ethnic Studies, Child Development, Liberal and Creative Arts, Engineering.
